Confiance.ai program / Confiance.ai Days 2022

CentraleSupélec Paris-Saclay, October 5-6

The Confiance.ai 22 poster session presents an opportunity to publish late-breaking results, technical descriptions, preliminary research contributions, works-in-progress and student projects in a concise and visible format. Accepted posters will be displayed in the forum venue, including a designated poster/demo session, providing presenters with an opportunity to engage in discussion with an expert audience of scientists and engineers from program partners<sup>1</sup> and other interested parties.

Posters can cover preliminary or exploratory work within the scope of the Confiance.ai program, or present any other research that would generate discussion and benefit from this forum. Posters are particularly encouraged in the following themes:

- Characterization of trust
- Operational Domain Definition
- Data for trustworthy AI
- Robustness
- Monitoring
- Explainability
- Trustworthy Human-Computer interaction
- Embedded trustworthy AI
- Trustworthy AI engineering

## 2. Submission instructions

- Poster submissions should be in a paper of two to four pages starting with a title, authors list and four-line abstract for the conference program;
- The paper should be sent as a PDF document to [posters.confiance.ai@irt-systemx.fr](mailto:posters.confiance.ai@irt-systemx.fr);
- Submissions will be reviewed by the program committee composed of members of the "Confiance.ai scientific animation working group".

## 3. Information for Authors

- All accepted posters will be considered for the best poster award to be determined by forum attendees;
- Authors of accepted posters are required to print their own poster and bring of to the forum venue in Paris-Saclay. Accepted posters will be provided with an Ao (841x1189mm) display area and will be scheduled for a two-minutes presentation (one slide) in front of all forum attendees;
- The poster presenter must be registered for the forum (free attendance), and must fill out the poster session authorization form, which will be provided in the acceptance email;
- Accepted poster titles, author names and affiliations and abstracts will be listed in the Conference Program which will be distributed to all attendees;
- Two to four-page extended abstracts of accepted posters will be included in the forum proceedings and will be published in the Confiance.ai workspace on HAL public library.
